City of the Village of Clarkston City Manager Report April 10, 2023

First NoHaz Collection Event April 29th

Starting this year, the City will be once again participating in Oakland County's NoHaz (hazardous waste) collection program. Under the program, City residents will be able drop off acceptable materials for \$15/carload, ensuring that the materials will be disposed of in a safe and environmentally responsible way. In 2023, there will be four collection events: April 29th, June 3rd, July 22nd and September 16th. Visit the County's NoHaz website (<u>www.nohaz.com</u>) to register for the events and for information on the program.

Spring Depot Park Work

Reconstruction of the original Depot Park Rain Garden has been scheduled for May. The redesign will provide a means for minimizing the impact of excess salt washing into the garden from the City Hall driveway. Additionally, the DPW team will soon start bringing in dirt to the main area of the park to provide a better, flatter base for the ice-skating rink. Our plan is to have the dirt graded and grass growing before the first Concert in the Park in June.

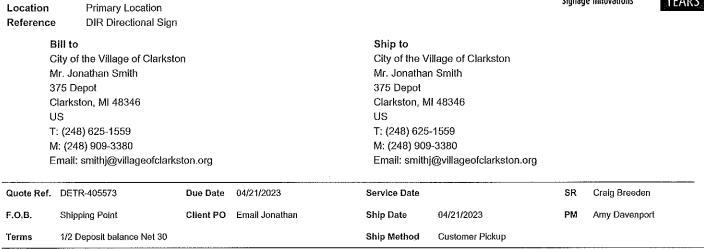

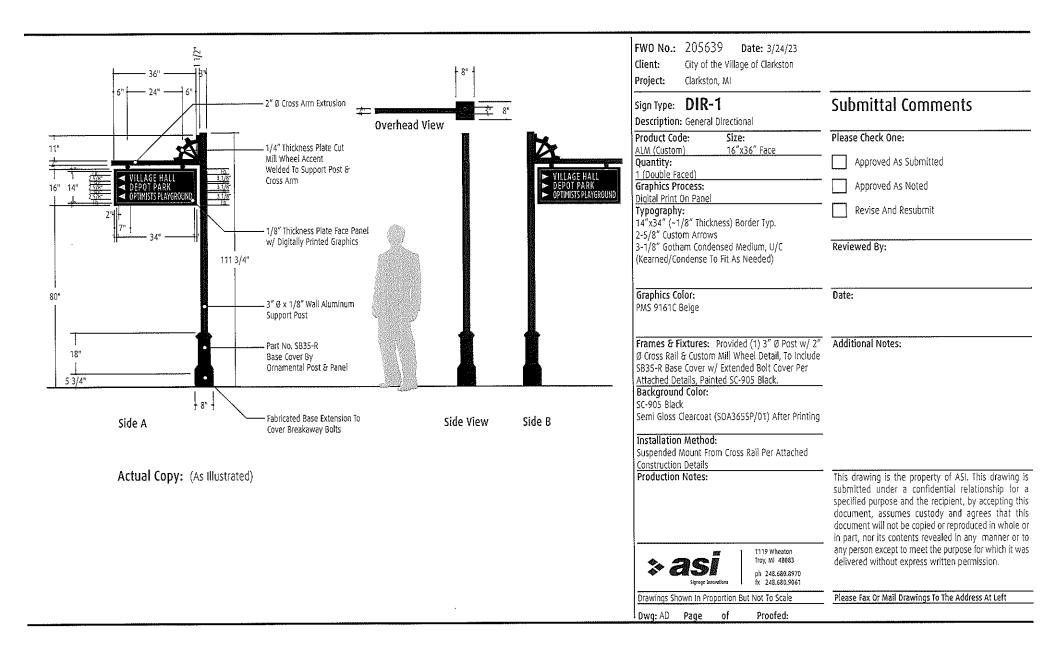

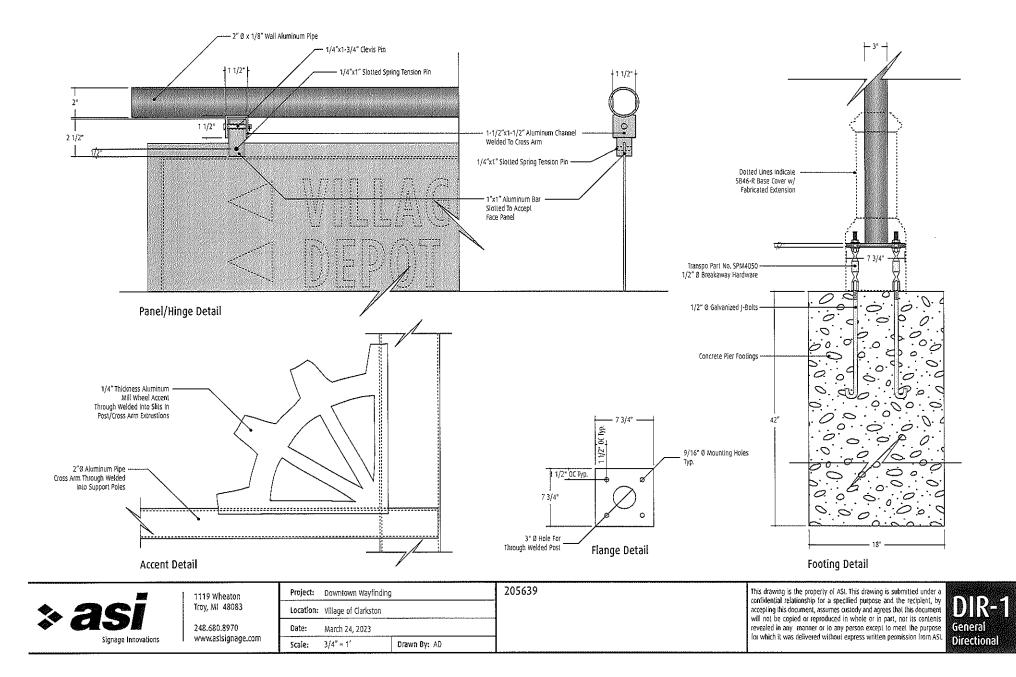
